Session 1: Department of Public Expenditure and Reform – Public Spending Code and Evaluation Workshop

- **Eoin Dormer - Assistant Principal, and Dr Fiachra Kennedy - Assistant Principal, of the Central Expenditure and Evaluation Unit (CEEU)** will provide a practical workshop illustrating appraisal and evaluation concepts in action. The aim of the session is to provide hands-on experience of working through a business case for new spending and a review of an existing expenditure scheme. The workshop will be structured around two team based case studies. Participants will be asked to work in groups with feedback and discussion at the end of the session. Please note that this workshop has been delivered to a selection of Government organisations in recent months.

Session 2: Presentations

- **Shane Carton, Deputy Director at the Comptroller and Auditor General's Office.** Shane will present on the recently issued special report 87 "Effectiveness of Audit Committees in State Bodies"
- **Angelo McNeive, Business Psychologist and Consultant.** Angelo will deliver a presentation entitled "Process Performance - the key to unlocking sustained improvement" which will address amongst other things the role of Key Performance Indicators (KPI's) in Business Process. Angelo is a business psychologist, strategist and facilitator with nearly twenty-five years consulting, organisational and leadership development experience with mid and senior level leaders in both the private and public sectors.
- **Public Expenditure update: Our current status.** The last 6 months have indicated an improvement in our public finances with increased revenues and expenditure efficiencies. A representative from the Expenditure unit of the Department of Public Expenditure and Reform will present an update on current policy including the Comprehensive Expenditure Reviews and the Medium Term Expenditure Framework.
